

Dia-Flat® Lapping Plate Instructions

- 1. Using a pencil, draw several intersecting lines on the surface to be flattened; a cross hatch pattern of lines an inch apart works well.
- 2. Place the Dia-Flat® Lapping Plate under a stream of water or immerse it into a shallow pan so that the diamond surface is under water.
 - **IMPORTANT**: Do not use in a sink that has a garbage disposal unit as the slurry is detrimental to the disposal bearings.
- 3. Abrade the surface to be flattened across the Dia-Flat® surface using long overlapping strokes in a figure "8" motion and light to moderate force be sure to use the entire Dia-Flat® surface. A figure "8" motion promotes even, consistent wear of the stone being flattened and the Dia-Flat® Lapping Plate. The figure "8" motion and finishing with lighter pressure will reduce any scratches from the flattening process.
- 4. Check the surface frequently to assess whether the pencil marks have been worn away. When the pencil marks are completely worn away, the surface is now flat.

Tip: use light force when finishing up for a smoother finish on the surface being lapped.
